3 points to stress:

- 1. If we don't get <u>at least</u> £275,000, we lose the pub!
- 2. There is a possibility of <u>Tax Relief</u> on your individual investments...we will let you know as soon as we know!
- 3. Our chances improve once we <u>own</u> the pub

Industry Benchmarking

- Based on data from 4100 member pubs, mostly tenanted and tied.
- The 'model' we compare against is the Rural character pub offering food and drink.
- Indicates our assumptions on food and drink sales, and food margin, are reasonable and achievable.
- The favourable gross margin on drinks is in line with expectations for a non-tied pub.
- Introduction of letting rooms is a small but significant element.
